This series encourages students into a deeper relationship with the One Jesus promises in Acts 1:8. Each week we'll unpack who the Holy Spirit is—the Person, His Purpose, His Power, and Our Partnership.

Week One

John 14:16–17, Acts 1:4–5

You can't understand the Holy Spirit's anointing if you don't know Him.

Week Two

1 Samuel 16:13, Luke 4:18–19

Anointing is God's empowerment for a specific purpose.

Week Three

Acts 1:8, Zechariah 4:6

We can't fulfill God's mission without His power.

Week Four

Ephesians 5:18, 2 Timothy 1:6–7

Anointing is not a one-time event — it's a daily choice to stay filled.

ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

As your kid starts their day, tell them, “You don’t have to have everything figured out today. I love who you are right now and I believe in you.”



Meal Time

At a meal this week, have everyone answer this question: “What’s the difference between knowing about someone and really knowing them?” Use the conversation to highlight that relationships grow through time and trust. Talk about how faith is not just learning information about God, but learning to know Him personally.



Drive Time

As you’re on the go this week, ask your kid, “When do you feel the most confident lately? When do you feel unsure?”



Bed Time

As your kid gets ready for bed, pray and thank God that He invites us into relationship, not performance. Pray that your child would grow in confidence knowing they are never alone and that the Holy Spirit is near.



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
